Submissions will be on display during the Arbor Day Celebration on April 30th at the Dumont Arboretum on West Shore Avenue starting at 1:00 PM. All are invited to attend the outdoor celebration. Submissions will be featured online LIVE during the celebration on the Dumont Shade Tree Commission Facebook page, Instagram account, and YouTube channel.

WHY DO WE NEED TREES? Trees provide:

- habitat for wildlife: birds, bees, and pollinators
- shade & reduced cooling costs in summer
- more oxygen & less air pollution
- a reduction in rainwater runoff & basement flooding
- a reduction in carbon footprint to offset global warming

- Please do not sign the front of your poster. The entry form below must be completed in its entirety and attached to the back. Please print clearly.

An image of the poster may be included in other publications, free or for sale, for the benefit of the Dumont Shade Tree Commission.
